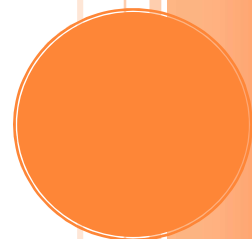

Preschool Director

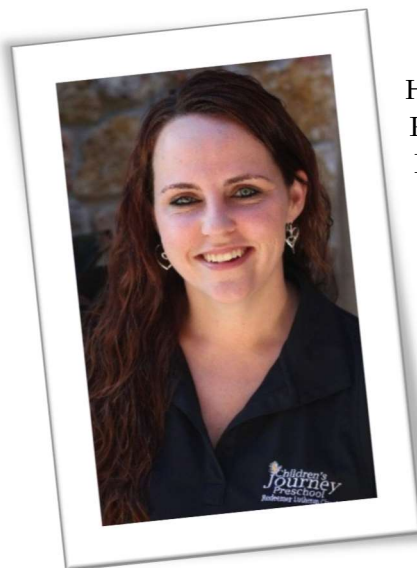

Meet your Early Preschool 2 (EP2) Teachers

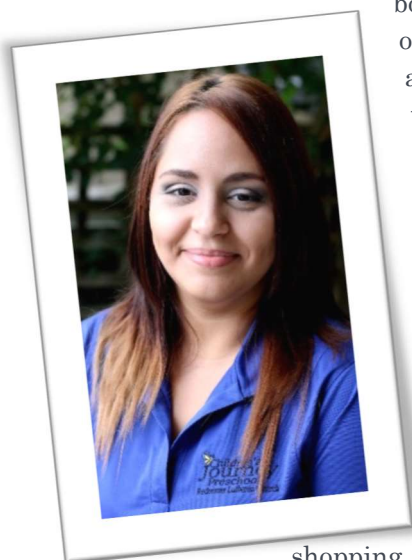


Hello, my name is **Tiffany Tyler** and I have lived in Orlando, FL. My whole life.

Meet your Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) Teachers

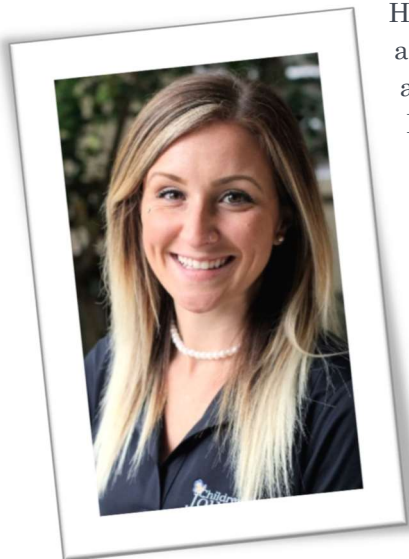
